Article # 3 On TRUTH! Spontaneous Generation created by TIME

In the first two articles on the subject of TRUTH we examined Cosmologist Carl Sagan's 5 minute UTube presentation on the "Beginning of the Universe" (15 billion years ago), and in conclusion we raised numerous questions which left the critical thinker wondering about the veracity of Sagan's presentation.

Was his presentation truthful regarding the origin of the Universe and the subsequent development of life out of inorganic matter? How about his postulation regarding the development of CONSCIOUSNESS, was that believable? Did he produce any kind of convincing evidence of his theories?

My answer is NO. It was not believable nor convincing that the Universe and subsequent development of life took the path he attempted to describe.

I have an alternative suggestion that requires less FAITH as to how it all began than the FAITH required to believe Mr. Sagan's postulation of the "beginning."

I firmly believe in the Biblical account of the beginning as described in Genesis chapter 1 & 2!

Genesis 1:1 KJV

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. Please read the rest of chapter 1 & 2 to get the full account of creation week. (And while you are at it, please read the rest of the Bible.)

This creation was a one-time supernatural "FIAT" creation, EX NIHILO (Out of NOTHING, see Hebrews 11:3, Romans 4:17, just to name a few).

This creation was accomplished in six literal 24 hour days, and included the initial creation of the Universe, light, earth, seas, vegetation, stars, fish, fowl, cattle, and the crowning act of God's creation - man in His own image.

He created a mature universe. Adam was created as a grown man. Trees had rings in them. Stars in distant galaxies already had lights shining and visible to the naked eye as God told Abraham to scan the heavens and consider the multitudes of stars in the night sky (Ge. 15:5). Everything was functioning according to the laws of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy that God created during creation week.

At the conclusion of creation week, God reviewed everything He had done and declared that everything was VERY GOOD.

This statement is important because later in this series of articles we will examine the fallacy of the GAP THEORY along with the illogical perspective of THEISTIC EVOLUTION.

Now, let's trace our way back to the part of Carl Sagan's presentation when he spoke about "hydrogen atoms that brought forth the STUFF OF LIFE."

As I mentioned before in the previous article, Sagan does not introduce the term "Spontaneous Generation," but this is THE CONCEPT held among all adherents to NATURALISTIC EVOLUTION that describes their presupposition as to HOW LIFE BEGAN.

The common definition of spontaneous generation is:

"The supposed production of living organisms from nonliving matter."

Notice that the definition starts with the word "supposed." It is assumed, and supposed to be true, but it has never been observed nor has it ever been produced in any lab. But, all EVOLUTIONISTS stake their reputation on this assumed phenomenon.

We will now review a number of quotes of well known evolutionists that deal with the concept of Spontaneous Generation.

George Wald (1906 - 1997) discusses the objection that life could not evolve spontaneously, by asserting that this judgment is based upon the human scale of experience and does not take into consideration the vast geological time available for the process. He states: "Time is in fact the hero of the plot. The time with which we have to deal is on the order of two billion years. What we regard as impossible on the basis of human experience is meaningless here. Given so much time, the impossible becomes possible, the possible becomes probable, and the probable virtually certain. One has only to wait: time itself performs the miracle."

You can read Wald's statement in an article published in "Scientific American" August 1954, pages 44 to 53. The title of the article is "Origin of Life."

(BTW, Wald also asserted in 1970 that we will cease to exist in 20 to 30 years if we don't take drastic action regarding Global Warming). We'll, we are still here.

The above statement from a "scientist" appears preposterous. All scientific rules and methods have been abandoned. I remember learning about the scientific method in High School.

The scientific method is the process of objectively establishing facts through testing and experimentation. The basic process involves making an observation, forming a hypothesis, making a prediction, conducting an experiment and finally analyzing the results. And being able to falsify the results by volitional adjustments of experimental parameters.

None of these principles are being employed by ideologically driven evolutionists. It seems that their mind has been made up, and they will skew all experimentation, such as the geological column, to produce billions of years to safeguard their supposed Spontaneous Generation.

The Biologist Leo Koch (1916 - 1982) agrees that given sufficient time "... the highly improbable occurs regularly and indeed is inevitable."

Keosian summarizes the attitude of mechanists (evolutionary materialists) "The mechanists were not discouraged by the enormous span of time required for this chance event. They point out that, given enough time, the most improbable becomes a statistical certainty. "

Many more similar statements could be produced. It is apparent that evolutionists worship at the shrine of time. This supposition has been so interwoven in the evolutionary hypothesis, that it now is written into text books as a proven fact.

"Much scientific effort has been expended in an attempt to show that eons of time are available for

evolution. Man, the planets, the Universe, the galaxies and matter are labeled as old by geological and radioactive dating methods. Time is not spoken of in terms of mere decades or centuries but as millions and billions upon billions years. The evolutionist says that time is all that is needed to accomplish the spontaneous generation of life. The evolutionary physicist, geologist and paleontologist assure him he has plenty of time to work with." "Creation - Evolution Controversy", R . L. Wysong, Inquiry Press, Midland, MI, 1990. (p 136 - 137).

There is an established Scientific Bias toward a really old Universe. The current stated age of the universe is said to be 15 to 18 billions of years, while the earth and our Solar System is said to be 4 to 5 billion years old.

On the other hand, there are numerous credible scientific organization which employ credentialed scientists who have done marvelous work in the scientific domain regarding the age of creation. Their claim, and they have proven data, that creation took place about 6 thousand years ago. In other words we are living in a young earth environment. (The New Answers Book 1, 2006 Answers In Genesis, p - 26)

This, of course stands in stark contrast to the claims of all the intelligentsia of current liberal universities and most scientific group think tanks.
