- v.12 Breaking God's Commandment results in DEATH Gen. 2:17
- v.13 Sin was in the world,
  BUT sin was not counted, because there was no LAW.

(Men did ignore God's general revelation (Ro.1:20, and their conscience (Ro 2:15), and it was sin, but it did not constitute a "transgression" because there was no direct command from God.)

- v.14a There was no explicit law from God, yet men died
- v.14b These men's sinning was NOT like Adam's transgression.
- v.12 They died because they sinned "in Adam."

  Greek use of the AORIST TENSE of all three verbs.

  An act done and completed in the past, "in Adam's loins."
- He. 7:10 Levi paid tithes to "M" while in the loins of Abraham.

Seminal Headship – the whole human race was seminally and physically in Adam's loins. When he sinned, I sinned! Therefore, I die!
