I. The Power of the Spirit in a Believer's Life (8:1-17)

Answers to law & flesh problem. In us is no good thing. Holy Spirit produces R+ in us. Holy Spirit = 20X, enables us to please God.

Gal 5:16

No Condemnation 1-4 No Obligation 5-17 No Separation 18-39

Victory over sin

Confirms our adoption v. 14-17

II Tim 1:7

There is a real struggle.

Creation Groans (22) Believers Groan (23) Holy Spirit Groans (26) Praying in the Spirit!!

In God's will!!

One day nature will be delivered from curse.

A. The Spirit gives a new WALK, (8:1)

- 1. **No condemnation** in Christ (1a)
- 2. Walk after the Spirit (1b)
- B. The Spirit gives LIFE (8:2-4)
 - 1. Freed from the law, sin, death (2)
 - 2. The law does not deliver (3a)
 - 3. Christ was ABLE to deliver (3b)
 - 4. We now are able to fulfill the "Law of Faith Ro.3:27" (4)
- C. The Spirit gives a new MIND (8:5-8)
 - 1. The carnal mind vs. the spiritual mind (5)
 - 2. Death vs. life and peace (6)
 - 3. The carnal mind opposes God (7-8)

Walk = new behavior Mind = new thinking "after" = our new nature

Nature, disposition, bent.

- D. The **Spirit dwells** within the believer (8:9)
- E. The **Spirit gives life** to the spirit of the believer (8:10-11)
 - 1. He gives life NOW (10)
 - 2. He will quicken the mortal body later (11)
- F. The **Spirit gives power** to mortify evil deeds (8:12-13)
 - 1. We do not owe the flesh any obedience (12)
 - 2. The choice: death or life (13)
- G. The **Spirit identifies the believer** as a son of God (8:14)
- H. The Spirit adopts (8:15)
 - 1. He delivers from the bondage of fear (15a)
 - 2. He gives access to God (15b)
- I. The **Spirit bears witness** with our Spirit (8:16-17)
 - 1. We are God's children (16)
 - 2. We are heirs (17a,b)
 - 3. We are conquerors over suffering (17c)

II. The Spirit Guarantees our Glory (8:18-27)

A. In this life, contrast **suffering** now vs. **glory** later (8:18)

- B. The creation suffers & struggles (8:19-22)
 - 1. Creation waits until God resurrects His children (19)
 - 2. Creation is subject to corruption (20)
 - 3. Creation will be delivered (21)
 - 4. Creation groans for deliverance (22)
- C. The believer suffers & struggles for deliverance (8:23-27)
 - 1. The first-fruits of the Spirit deliver & save him (23)
 - 2. Hope in a SURE promise (24-25)
 - 3. Prayer of the Spirit delivers & saves (26)
 - 4. God delivers and saves (27)

III. Eternal Security Assured (8:28-39)

- A. Assurance 1: God works things out for those who love Him (28)
- B. Assurance 2: God has determined to **fulfill His purpose** for believers (29)
- C. Assurance 3: God has set **GLORIFICATION** for believers (30)
- D. Assurance 4: God has acted for the believers (31-33)
 - 1. He is our Savior (32a)
 - 2. He is or Provider (32b)
 - 3. He is our Justifier (33)
- E. Assurance 5: Christ does not condemn the believer (34)
 - 1. He died for us (34a)
 - 2. He arose for us (34b)
 - 3. He was exalted for us (34c)
 - 4. He intercedes for us (34d)
- F. Assurance 6: Christ protects the believer (35-37)
- G. Assurance 7: Christ protects the believer from **most extreme** circumstances and forces (38-39)
