The REQUIREMENT for Salvation is always FAITH

The **CONTENT** of Faith depends on God's revelation in that dispensation

Abraham simply believed what God told him at that time.

Today we must believe what God told us through Christ. (John 14:6; 5:24) (Charles Ryrie, "Dispensationalism Today")

- 6. Sin abounded, BUT **GRACE abounded MORE** (20)

SANCTIFICATION

A. Silly question (1)

B. **KNOW** (3-10)

- 1. Baptized into Christ (3; II Cor. 12:13; Gal 3:27; Col 2:12; II Tim 2:11)
- 2. Identified with Christ in His death (3)
- 3. Identified with Christ in His resurrection (5)

- 4. The old man is crucified with Him (6; Gal 2:20)
- 5. Having died to sin means we are released from the TYRANNY, POWER, DOMINION, CONTROL of sin. We NOW can say NO to SIN!

Please NOTE: The biblical definition of DEATH is SEPARATION, - not annihilation. We are separated from the POWER of SIN.

C. RECKON (11)

- 1. Therefore, consider this to be true because GOD says IT IS TRUE!!!!
- 2. You are DEAD to sin, BUT alive to God (11)

D. YIELD (13)

- 1. Yield to R+
- 2. Do NOT yield to UN-R+
- E. We are **NOT UNDER the LAW**, but under **GRACE** (14)
- F. Two kinds of FRUIT (21-23)
 - 1. Fruits of UN-R+ = DEATH (21)
 - 2. Fruits of R+ = Eternal Life (22)
